Monday: Scripture: Romans 3:19-28
 Key Thought: Justification is an act of God's free grace.

Tuesday: Scripture: Exodus 34:6-7; Micah 7:14-20
 Key Thought: In justification, God pardons all our sins.

Wednesday: Scripture: Philippians 3:1-9
 Key Thought: In justification, God accepts us as righteous in His sight.

Thursday: Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Ephesians 2:8-10
 Key Thought: In justification, Christ's righteousness is imputed to us.

Friday: Scripture: Romans 4:1-23; Galatians 2:16
 Key Thought: Christ's righteousness is received by faith alone.
