Regarding *El Shaddai*: This Hebrew name of God is translated "Almighty" forty-eight times in the Old Testament. In the New Testament, the Greek equivalent is used in II Corinthians 6:18 and Revelation 1:8; 4:8; 11:17; 15:3; 16:7, 14; 19:6, 15; 21:22. In Revelation 19:6, it is translated *omnipotent*.

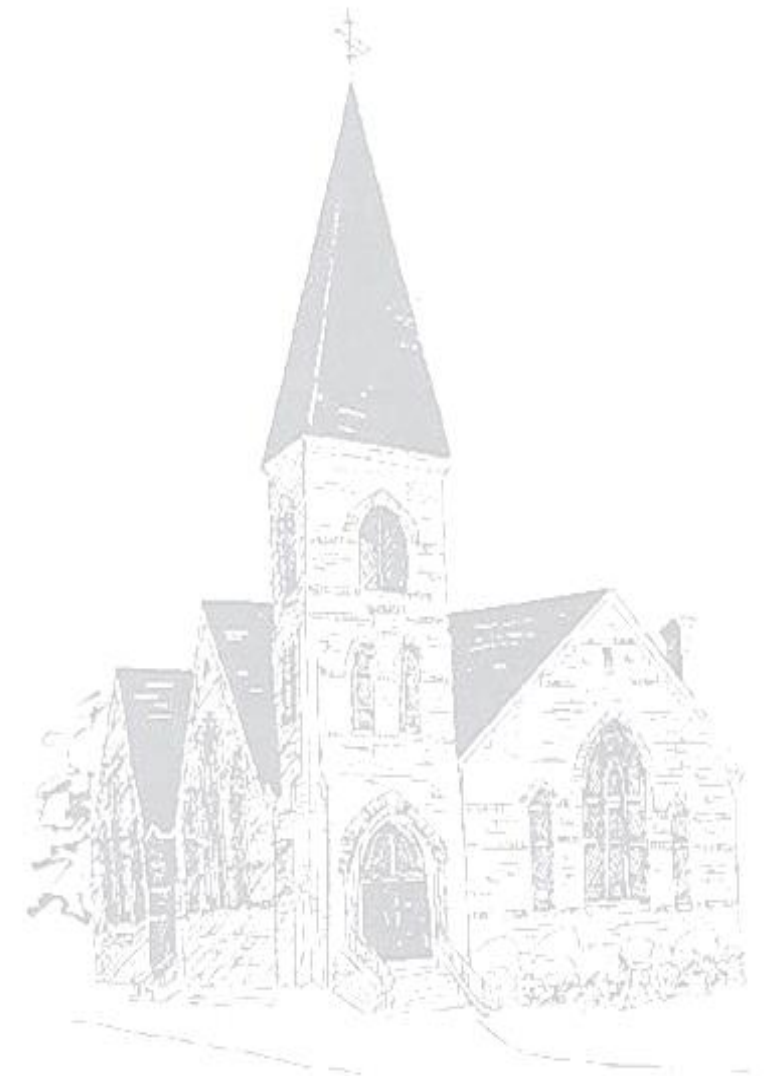
