

**Growth Questions for 9/26 – 10/3**

1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find most helpful, eye-opening, troubling?
2. Think back over your experience. What is the most meaningful celebration of the Lord's Supper you've ever been part of? What made that particular occasion so special?
3. In what way or ways were the Corinthians corrupting the celebration of the Lord's Supper?
4. What foundational truths about the Lord's Supper does Paul teach in this passage? What is its purpose?
5. What sober instructions did Paul give the Corinthian Christians for preparing to participate in the Lord's Supper?
6. Paul speaks of communion as being a remembrance. What sort of things should Christians remember when partaking of the Lord's Supper? Take time to read and reflect on Matt. 26:26–29; Rom. 8:1; 2 Cor. 5:17; Eph. 1:7; 1 Thess. 4:16–18.

1. How important is the Lord's Supper to you? How does this study change the way you view this ordinance?
2. Read Acts 2:42–47. How was the church at Corinth different from the church described here in Acts? What was the result of how the church in Acts functioned? How is the Church at Martinsburg seeing this take place each week?
3. How do you intend to prepare yourself spiritually before you participate next time in the Lord's Supper?
4. What instructions/encouragements would you give a new Christian, a non-Christian, or a seasoned Christians before he or she took Communion?
5. Share with one another how the Lord's Supper/Communion demonstrates the Gospel. See 1 Corinthians 15:3-4. Why is the message of communion so important? Why must the church regularly observe communion?
