1. D In 1500 B.C., it was believed the earth sat on a large animal or a giant. Science didn't discover the earth hangs upon nothing...as the Bible says...until 1650.
2. B Only in recent years has science discovered that everything we see is composed of things that we cannot see – invisible atoms; as noted in the Bible 2,000 years ago.

5. F God asked Job the strangest question in 1500 B.C. that appeared to be scientifically ludicrous. Yet, 3300 years later, our society is used to electromagnetic radiation. It was 1864 when James Clerk Maxwell suggested that electricity, x-rays, light & radio waves are forms of the same thing.
6. C The Bible described a “cycle” of air currents 2000 years ago before scientists discovered how they work: The air around the earth turns in huge circles: clockwise in one hemisphere and counter-clockwise in the other.
