GENERAL:



MATERIALS ALLOWED:

Wood String

Plastics Glue

DESIGN AND CONTEST RULES:

- 1. No kits or pre-made designs may be used. The structure must be the individual's invention.
- 2. The structure must be completely released (no strings or other attachments). NO PARACHUTES!
- 3. Grade A Large eggs will be supplied at the competition. You cannot bring your own egg.
- 4. All containers will be inspected by an AWANA Judge before they are dropped.
- 5. Once an egg is put inside the structure, that egg cannot be exchanged with another.

(TURN OVER)

- 6. The egg must be easily accessible after the drop to check for any cracking.
- 7. The level at which an egg is cracked (either fully or partially) will be determined by the judges. A partially cracked egg will have a slight opening but will not leak. A fully cracked egg is when the inside contents of the egg have been leaked.
- 8. The winner will be determined by the container with the greatest total score.
- 9. HAVE FUN!!!!!!!

SCORING RUBRIC:

Standard Points

- 25 points if the egg shows no signs of cracking
- 20 points if the egg does not fully crack after the first drop

Extra Points

- 10 points if the container is less than 2 pounds
- 20 points if the container is less than 1 pound
- 5 points for incorporating your team colors

PRIZES:

Based on the total score, there will be 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes for both Sparks and T&T. If there is a tie, we will drop each egg from a higher location to determine a winner.
