


37 While Jesus was speaking, a Pharisee asked him to dine with him, so he went in and reclined at table.

38 The Pharisee was astonished to see that he did not wash before dinner.



In 1855, abolitionist and educator John Fee estimated that ministers of the gospel and members of Protestant churches owned a total of 660,563 slaves whose total value amounted to \$264 million. (Adjusted for inflation, the sum is the equivalent to about \$8 billion today).

However, it was not individual members or ministers of local churches alone but local churches themselves that owned slaves. In this perverse and galling practice, congregations purchased slaves who were hired out to the highest bidder on an annual basis.

The compensation for the leased labor of the slaves typically paid the minister's salaries—over the course of one hundred years in one church's case thereby relieving congregants of the responsibility of contributing personal tithes and offerings.



### Let's Receive the Diagnosis




Religion / DIY spirituality is very good at helping you create carefully edited versions of yourself to show to God and to the the world, but Jesus has come to change us from the inside out.


