
AKA "THE CIRCUMCISION PARTY"

The logic of the "circumcision party" seemed to be that if God made a covenant with Abraham and gave him the sign of circumcision as a sign of the covenant, and if Jesus is the fulfillment of God's covenant with Abraham, then these new followers of Jesus must be circumcised too.








The people of Israel called non-Israelites, "dogs," essentially wild animals who lived outside the holy nation of Israel.

The Judaizers thought they were doers of good, but according to Paul, they were doers of evil because they were taking people's eyes off of Jesus and redirecting their gaze to their own efforts / good works.

By insisting that followers of Jesus be circumcised in order to be saved, Paul brands these Judaizers as those who simply mutilate the flesh, like those in pagan religions who tried to get the attention of the gods by the cutting and bleeding their flesh. 3 For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh—
