Hebrews 4:14

[14] Since then we have a **great high priest** who has **passed through the heavens**, Jesus, the Son of God, let us **hold fast our confession**.

“His entrance into the Holy of Holies was through three portals. First, he bore the blood through the door into the outer court . Second, he entered another door into the Holy Place . And third, he entered through the veil of the Holy of Holies . Thus, the ancient high priest had a three-portaled entrance in coming before the thrice holy God—and he had to do it year after year.” - R. Kent Hughes
