## **Sermon Text**

John 2: 1-11, NASB

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there; <sup>2</sup> and both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding. <sup>3</sup> When the wine ran out, the mother of Jesus \*said to Him, "They have no wine." <sup>4</sup> And Jesus \*said to her, "What business do you have with Me, woman? My hour has not yet come." <sup>5</sup> His mother \*said to the servants, "Whatever He tells you, do it." <sup>6</sup> Now there were six stone waterpots standing there for the Jewish custom of purification, containing two or three measures each. <sup>7</sup> Jesus \*said to them, "Fill the waterpots with water." So they filled them up to the brim. <sup>8</sup> And He said to them, "Draw some out now and take it to the headwaiter." And they took it to him. <sup>9</sup> Now when the headwaiter tasted the water which had become wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the headwaiter , called the groom, <sup>10</sup> and \*said to him, "Every man serves the good wine first, and when the guests are drunk, then he serves the poorer wine; but you have kept the good wine until now." <sup>11</sup> This beginning of His signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and revealed His glory; and His disciples believed in Him.
