WHERE TO BEGIN?

Paul was faithful to share gospel truth even with Felix, who was so immoral and scary. Was there ever anyone you knew who became a Christian even though you would have given it zero chance?

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

What was your biggest takeaway from the message?

Paul treated Felix with compassion and respect even though Paul was detained while totally innocent. What circumstances, even in church, are most likely to lead you to treat someone with lack of respect?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

What aspects of Christianity are likely to offend your friends or neighbors who are not believers?

In explaining the gospel, Paul confronted Felix with the truth of sin, including Felix's own. Have you ever done that when explaining the gospel to someone?

PRAY

Pray that Christ and His love will lead us to gospel faithfulness.
