WHERE TO BEGIN?

Is there someone you're especially thankful for this week?

DIGGING IN: What was the message about?

Paul prays in verse 9 that the Philippians' love would abound more and more. Do you think that your own love continues to grow? If so, in what ways? If not, have you thought about the reasons?

In verse 10, Paul wants the Philippians to approve what is excellent. What do you think that means? Do you ever approve things that are not excellent?

LIVE IT OUT: What do we do?

Do you ever need encouragement? In what areas? Does anything in this passage encourage you?

Do you ever have trouble believing God will complete a good work in you (v. 6)?

[Family Question]: What are the ways we feel encouraged? Discouraged?

PRAY

Pray that we would see that God is completing a good work in us .
