<sup>1</sup>I will extol you, O Lord, for you have drawn me up  
and have not let my foes rejoice over me.

<sup>2</sup>O Lord my God, I cried to you for help,  
and you have healed me.

<sup>3</sup>O Lord, you have brought up my soul from Sheol;  
you restored me to life from among those who go down to the pit.

<sup>4</sup>Sing praises to the Lord, O you his saints,  
and give thanks to his holy name.

<sup>5</sup>For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime.  
Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

<sup>6</sup>As for me, I said in my prosperity,  
“I shall never be moved.”

<sup>7</sup>By your favor, O Lord, you made my mountain stand strong;  
you hid your face; I was dismayed.

<sup>8</sup>To you, O Lord, I cry,  
and to the Lord I plead for mercy:

<sup>9</sup>“What profit is there in my death, if I go down to the pit?  
Will the dust praise you? Will it tell of your faithfulness?”

<sup>10</sup>Hear, O Lord, and be merciful to me!  
O Lord, be my helper!”

<sup>11</sup>You have turned for me my mourning into dancing;  
you have loosed my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness,

<sup>12</sup>that my glory may sing your praise and not be silent.

O Lord my God, I will give thanks to you forever!
