

Stage 2 Kids and Preschool Worship Plan

Wellness

- If anyone in your household has had a fever of 100.4° or more in the last 24 hours, or if your child has a cough or runny nose, we would ask you to stay home and watch the service. Please join us again when everyone is well.
- Masks will be worn by volunteers when social distancing cannot be adhered to, such as when a child needs to be held, during diapering, etc. Masks will not be required for children.

Parking

- Park in the preschool/office parking area.

Check-In (This procedure may take extra time. Please arrive early. We will begin checking children in at 9:15 a.m.)

- Enter through the Adult Discipleship Hall glass doors (there will be a sign).
- Proceed down the hall to the central check-in area for all Preschoolers and Kids.
- Please utilize floor markings to remain 6 feet apart when waiting to check in and receive security tags.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at check-in. We ask that you apply to your children's hands before they enter their classroom.
- Without entering the classroom, drop off your child quickly and proceed to the sanctuary through the main hallway. In order to keep the flow moving, traffic will be one way.
- Do not use this time to socialize with volunteers or other families.
- Location of classrooms:
 - Kids Worship - Grades 1-3 - After check-in, they will be sent upstairs where their teacher will greet them and bring them to the Kids Worship room.
 - Wee Worship - 2½-year-olds - Kindergarten - Fellowship Hall (separated into 2 groups)
 - Walker Class - Room 205 (next to the stairs)
 - Infant nursery - At this time, this room will be self-service. Feel free to watch the service while you let your child play. Any toys played with should be left in the dirty toy bin at the door.

Pick up

- Upon exiting the sanctuary, you will return the way you came. You will stop at the check-out desk where you will present your security tag. A volunteer will call for your child(ren) to meet you. We ask that you not enter the classroom.
- Please wait using 6 feet social distancing markings.
- You will exit through the same glass doors through which you entered.
- Please do not stop and socialize in the hallway.
- It is suggested that you use hand sanitizer on your children's hands upon leaving their classrooms.

Diaper bags/backpacks

- At this time, diaper bags or backpacks will not be brought into the classroom. You may bring a diaper in a labeled Ziploc bag only. If a change of clothes is needed, we will text you. If your child needs a pacifier or security item then please label and provide that in the Ziploc bag.

Snacks/Sippy Cups/Outside Toys

- Sippy cups will only be allowed in the Walker classroom. They MUST be labeled with the child's name.
- No food, drinks, or outside toys will be allowed in the classrooms. While we only have one service, we will not be providing snacks during Wee Worship or in the Walker classroom. Please make sure that your children are fed before they arrive.

In the classroom

- While it is difficult to keep small children socially distant from each other, seating and play areas are set up in a way to provide enough space.
- Children will be provided with their own Ziploc bag of crayons and craft supplies to limit sharing.
- For now, while we will be coloring and making crafts to re-enforce our Bible story, we will not be sending these home.
- You may pick up a Gospel Project Big Picture Card at the check-out table to take home.
