Reach Up

Prayer Highlight: Pray for our Easter Service that the message of the Gospel would move throughout our community.

Worship Ministry

- o Pray as we prepare for and lead our Easter Service.
- Pray for additional volunteers to serve in the areas of technical productions and choir.
- o Praise God for the new volunteers to our team as it continues to grow.

Congregational Worship
