Membership Department ♦ Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How long are the membership classes?

A: Membership classes are held on Sundays prior to morning worship service. Classes are approximately 50 minutes in length and lasts for eight consecutive weeks.

Q: What is the membership process?

A: The NCBC membership process is not difficult. First, prospective members attend an orientation with our membership personnel. After the orientation, prospective members are required to complete our membership course.

Q: Can I participate in ministry if I am not a member?

A: Prospective members cannot serve in a leadership capacity if membership classes are not completed. However, prospective members can participate in the following ministries without completing classes:

- ☞ Empowerment Zones
- ☞ Men / Women Fellowship activities
- ☞ Y.E.S. Teen Fellowship activities

Q: What are the membership office hours?

A: NCBC guests and members are served on Sundays at the following times: 8:30 am and immediately after service for approximately 30-45 minutes.

Q: If I want to serve in ministry, what are my next steps?

A: The first step to begin serving in ministry is to complete a *Ministry Interest Form*. This form can be picked up and submitted to the Member and Guest Services office. After completion and submission, the respective ministry leader will contact you regarding ministry information and opportunities.
