Question Two

Why aren't we first moving towards 3 services?

We still have capacity in our worship center. Phase One of the master plan seeks to address the crisis of educational space. Even if we did add an additional service, we would struggle to staff that service with childcare, and therefore another service would not effectively address the most pressing problem our church is facing. If the church continues to grow, a three-service model is one that we are willing to entertain on a limited basis. If such a step were to become necessary, it would only be with an

understanding that further expansion must be pursued that would enable us to go back to fewer services.

The reason for this is threefold:

- 1. The burden upon ministry staff and volunteers in a multiservice model is prohibitive
- 2. The burden of staffing childcare (youth, children, nursery) is prohibitive
- 3. The relational impact of subdividing the church body to this degree over the long term is prohibitive.
