What is a Discipleship Pastor?

In accordance with the instructions of Ephesians 4:12-13, a discipleship Pastor is responsible for creating and managing the aspects of our church that make disciples and encourages Christian maturity. This begins by being a link to our outreach efforts, welcome ministry, general pastoral care, men's and women's ministry, and equipping ministries, (including the oversight of bible studies, small groups, equip classes). In short, a good discipleship pastor does not seek to do all the discipleship himself, he seeks to create an environment where the people of the church actively engage in the discipleship of one another. This role is essential in a growing church to ensure that every person within the church has a clear pathway to the next step in their maturity in Christ.
