## **Wellness Policy**

We desire to provide the safest possible environment for your child. Therefore, we operate a well-baby nursery. For the protection of all the children in our ministry, we ask that you keep your child out of the nursery if he displays any of the following symptoms.

- Fever
- Rash
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Persistent cough and/or runny nose
- Sore throat
- Nausea
- Pinkeye (conjunctivitis)
- Communicable diseases (like chicken pox)

At times children become ill suddenly. Should your child exhibit signs of illness, we will isolate him from the other children and contact you immediately. We will also notify the medical staff if we feel your child would benefit from additional care.

Thank you in advance for helping us keep our nursery a healthy environment for all.

The health and well-being of your child is very important to us. While we cannot ever ensure a totally germ-free environment, we strive to make our nursery rooms the cleanest in the church. But if you see anything that needs attention, please let us know. The following is a list of the key ways we seek to ensure the cleanliness of our nursery.

- The nurseries are cleaned after each service or event.
- All hand toys are cleaned with disinfectant after each service or event.
- Cribs are disinfected and sheets are changed after every use.
- Changing tables are disinfected immediately after each diaper change.
- Volunteers use non-latex gloves for changing diapers and wiping noses.
- Shoe covers are provided for our volunteers in the infant room in order to keep the area clean for crawling babies.
