A Story for the Storyless

(Luke 24.13-35)

OPENER

How are you doing? (i.e. Rank your week 1-5, high-low, etc.)

STUDY/DISCUSSION

>> READ >> Luke 24.13-35

1. What stands out to you from this story? What is encouraging/challenging/provocative/confusing?
2. The disciples at one point say: "We had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel." Jesus *was* the Redeemer but not in the way they expected (even though he told them repeatedly he'd rise again). Is there a time you've felt or said: "I had hoped God would _____" because things weren't going as you expected? If you feel comfortable, share about that. How did God actually fulfill your hope but maybe in a way you never expected?
3. Do you have a moment of "clarity" in your walk with Jesus? That is, was there a time for you when the penny dropped, when things fell into place, when it "clicked" for you?
4. In what ways can you share with others the good news of Easter (and the good news of how *you* have experienced Jesus)?
5. How can we be caring for one another and our neighbors especially during this "stay at home" time?

PRAY

Take some time and pray together. Pray "conversationally." Pray *for* each other and pray specifically for our eyes to be opened to God's faithfulness and goodness even during this stay at home time.
