- 1.) What stands out to you as significant, helpful, or confusing from this passage?
- 2.) What does it mean that Jesus gives abundant (or full) life?
- 3.) Practically speaking, how do we follow the Shepherd’s lead? What does that look like?
- 4.) Read the passages below. How do they complement or elaborate upon the message of John 10?

- 5.) How would you respond to this statement: “If the Shepherd is so good, why do his people suffer?”
- 6.) Ezekiel 34 makes it clear that there are bad leaders within the church. We know how terrible shepherding of this sort affects the world’s view of ministry. What about the way it affects the flock’s view of the church? How does a flock recover from the devastation of scandal? How does the church protect itself from such poor leadership?
