SERMON

INCORRUPTIBLE LOVE  
REV. DAVID SENTERS

Notes referenced in the Apostles' Creed:

\*Heidelberg Catechism Q. 44: "Why is there added, 'He descended into hell?' A. That in my greatest temptations I may be assured, and wholly comfort myself with this, that my Lord Jesus Christ, by His inexpressible anguish, pains, terrors, and hellish agony in which He was plunged during all His sufferings, but especially on the cross, has delivered me from the anguish and torment of hell." We do not believe that Jesus actually went to Hell-only that He endured eternal punishment as an eternal being on the cross under the eternal wrath of God.

\*\*Heidelberg Catechism Q. 54: "What do you believe concerning 'the holy catholic church'? A. That the Son of God from the beginning to the end of the world, gathers, defends, and preserves to Himself by His Spirit and word, out of the whole human race, a church chosen to everlasting life, agreeing in true faith; and that I am and forever shall remain, a living member thereof." We do not mean what "the Roman Catholic Church" means by their use of the phrase catholic. The word "catholic" merely means "universal."
