## Romans 8:9-17 Study Questions for Mid-week Small Group

1. What three titles does the Apostle Paul give the Holy Spirit in verses 9-11? Is Paul suggesting that the Holy Spirit became God the Father and God the Son? If not, how do we explain the fact that He is called “the Spirit of Christ?”
2. Why is it important for the Holy Spirit to be the Spirit of Christ?
3. What event in the life of Christ does Paul fixate on when speaking of the work of the Spirit in the life of believers? How does this relate to the argument of the rest of the chapter?
4. How does the call to holiness fit in with Paul’s teaching on adoption into God’s family?
5. What is the defining mark of the child of God? Is everyone a child of God?
6. What three things does Paul tell us that the Spirit of the Son does in or to us?
7. What is the “leading of the Spirit” in the text?
8. What role does the Spirit play in our assurance of salvation?
