1. What is Paul communicating in this section? What does this section reveal about the letter to the Romans on the whole?
2. What is significant about Paul's desire to go to Spain in light of what Jesus taught in Matthew 18:18-20?
3. Where is Paul planning on going after a short visit to the church of Rome and before he goes to Spain?
4. What is Paul's purpose for going to Jerusalem? What is he taking with him? Where is it coming from? What does Paul tell us is significant about where it comes from?
5. What is Paul's purpose for going to Rome? What two things is he hoping to get from that visit?
6. What does Paul ask for from the believers in Rome? How is that instructive to us as we think of the needs of ministers?
7. What should motivate us to be the sort of church that the church at Rome was in Paul's sight? What will serve to make us a joyful, welcoming and nurturing church?
8. How can we apply the various lessons in this passage to our own lives and fellowship?
