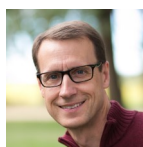

About the Conference

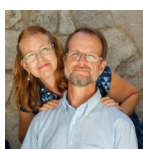

About Our Speakers



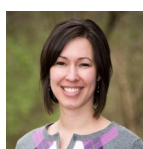
