Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use estimation to complete long division with multiple digit divisors• Solve multi-step story problems and measurement problems independently• Follow fraction rules to correctly add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions• Work with improper fractions and mixed numbers• Work with decimals• Find percentages of a number and understand the concept of percents• Understand area, perimeter, and circumference• Use checking and estimation to identify and correct mistakes independently• Solve simple algebraic equations
History/Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Answer comprehension questions independently by identifying key ideas in the text to find answers• Develop note taking skills• Plan ahead to study for tests• Know major land areas and geographic regions• Develop awareness of how each era of history relates to the whole
Independent work	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Complete long-term projects demonstrating time management and responsibility• Organize assignments and materials independently (planners, supplies, homework, etc.)• Develop study skills• Follow written multi-step directions independently
