



## ARCHBISHOP'S SCHOOL FOR YOUNG LEADERS

HOSTED BY THE NEXT GENERATION LEADERSHIP INITIATIVE

Welcome to the Archbishop's School for Young Leaders! You are receiving this application because you are a leader and influencer. God has already called you to make an impact among his people.

The Archbishop, as the senior bishop in the Anglican Church, is inviting you to join him in an experience built to explore your identity as a leader and equip you to lead others. This experience is for students who were enrolled in 10-12th grade during the spring of 2021, and will be held virtually during the Provincial Council gathering, June 13-15, 2021. The Archbishop's School for Young Leaders (ASYL) provides an intimate view of leadership in the Anglican Church, offers diverse speakers, facilitates reflection on our own life purpose and gifting, and leads discussion on how the Anglican Church can partner with you to lead the next generation.

During our time together, young leaders will learn vital leadership skills while focusing on the six key initiatives outlined by Archbishop Beach. These initiatives will guide young leaders in a Kingdom project within their own communities, to be completed over the 10-months following our time together in June. Young Leaders and their local student ministry leader (youth pastor, rector, or adult volunteer) will identify an area to strengthen within their community. Each young leader will choose an initiative upon which to base their project and ASYL will walk alongside you and your team to support, witness, celebrate you through monthly virtual gatherings.

Young leaders will be led by Bishop Steven Tighe, Rev. Dr. Jessica Jones as the Canon for the Next Generation Leadership Initiative, Rev. Aaron Buttery, the provincial Director of the Student Leadership Network, and other provincial leaders. The Next Generation Leadership Initiative is raising up the next generation of leaders for the next generation of the ACNA. The Anglican Church is your church. The Archbishop is calling you to lead it well.

To apply, complete [this application](#) by May 1. We do expect your honesty and transparency in your responses. All applicants will be notified by May 12 as to their acceptance status for this June. Not every person who applies will be invited to ASYL. If you are not approved for this year, we will provide feedback on why and what to do between now and applying again.
