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Lesson 1 – Noah – TREND BREAKER

Think about how Noah was different to everyone else. He followed God and was saved from the storm

Craft – rainbow print out, can you make a rainbow by gluing coloured tissue on the picture?

Because Noah was different and did what God asked, God promised not to flood the earth again and sent the rainbow to show this.

Thank you, God for Noah, that he broke the trend and did the right thing. Amen

Playdough mix – adult job

Put the contents of the box into a big bowl

Add 1 tablespoon of veg oil

Add cup boiling water

stir till combined

Leave to cool a little then kneed (once cooled child can kneed)

Once cooled it will keep in the box provided for up to 6 months (I keep it in the fridge)

Contents of box

Salt,

Flour

Cream of tartar

Lesson 2 – Elijah – ALTAR BREAKER

Think about how Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal with his worship of God. He proved God was the only god. He was the only prophet left and stood his ground.



Flame stick craft – cut some strips of crepe paper and using Sellotape stick them to the end of the lolly stick so you can wave them.

You could make an altar shape out of your playdough

In Elijah's time an altar would have been a square of stones, you could act the story out with your fire sticks.

Elijah Knew that God would be able to light the fire

Thank you, God, that you lit the fire showing us you are real

Lesson 3 – Three Friends – RULE BREAKERS

Think about how Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego broke the rules to follow God.

Using the prepared furnace –

peel the paper off the sticky back plastic

using tissue/crepe paper stick small pieces to cover the sticky bit.

Encourage the children to cut (or cut for them) the people out

Using glue add the people to the fire you have created.

Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were thrown into a fire, but trusted God that they would be safe.

Lesson 4 – Jesus – TOMB BREAKER

Think about how because Jesus is the son of God, he can break tombs open. Think about his resurrection.

Resurrection rolls

we are showing how Jesus was put away in a tomb. (Jesus is the marshmallow) Once baked and cooled open up the bun, peek inside and find no more marshmallow. Jesus wasn't in the tomb on Easter morning he had broken out alive.

– this is an activity that needs a break of an hour in the middle (we are making bread)

From home you will need a

baking tray

Vegetable oil

In a big bowl Mix the labelled flour/salt/yeast mixture with
1 tablespoon of oil

340ml warm not hot water and mix to a dough. (you may need to add a little more water) encourage the children to mix and kneed at this point.

Once mixed cut into 6 pieces and roll out with your rolling pin
put a marshmallow in the middle of each one and wrap the dough around the marshmallow and pinch closed, or you can roll it in your hands to make a ball

Place on a baking tray with pinched bit underneath

With the clean paint brush paint with vegetable oil

And sprinkle with sugar/cinnamon mixture

Leave for an hour in a warm place

Heat oven to 175 or gas 3

Bake rolls for 10-15 mins

Once cooled open and look for Jesus – not there he broke out alive :)

Lesson 5 – Peter – CROWD BREAKER

Think about how on the day of Pentecost, Peter stood before a crowd and spoke about Jesus. Many became followers of Jesus that day.

Add a small cone to the back of each fire with Sellotape

Put on the end of the straw and blow
How far can you get your “fire to go?”

Lesson 6 – Paul – CHAIN BREAKER

Think about how Paul and Silas in prison trusted in God and were set free and even told the jailer about Jesus too.

Using the strips provided can you make chains using glue or selotape?
