## How to use Talk It Over:

### **Back to the Future - Pt 3: The Gospel & Manhood**

#### **1 Corinthians 3:11**

#### **Discussion Questions**

- Was there a wow moment in this week's sermon? What stood out?
- Do we tend to see work as a blessing or a burden? How does the Gospel change how we view work?
- Where do we see male passivity in our culture? Why should we reject passivity? (Read Phil 2:6-8)
- How do we transfer male leadership seen in hobbies & recreation to family life (direction, career, etc.)?
- When do you think a boy becomes a man?
- How can we as a Christian community spur one another on to accept responsibility? What does this look like on a daily basis?
- Leading courageously is shown through Jesus. Read together and discuss Luke 24:50 and John 10:11.

## **Optional Questions (Digging Deeper)**

- Discuss the importance of discipleship. Who are you discipling? Who or what are you pointing them to?
- Who is in your life that you give permission to speak into your life?
- Who do you perhaps need to reach out to and ask them to invest in you? Who do you need to reach out to and perhaps offer to invest into?

Romans 5:17-19

## **A DEFINITION FOR AUTHENTIC MANHOOD**

### **1. REJECT \_\_\_\_\_**

- Jesus rejected passivity. (Philippians 2:6-8)
- Adam was passive in the Garden. (Genesis 3:5-6)

### **2. ACCEPT \_\_\_\_\_**

- Jesus accepted responsibility for a \_\_\_\_\_. (John 6:38)

- Jesus accepted responsibility for a \_\_\_\_\_. (John 17:4)
- Jesus accepted responsibility for a \_\_\_\_\_. (Ephesians 5:25)

### 3. LEAD \_\_\_\_\_

- Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ his disciples. (Luke 24:50)
- Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ down his life. (John 10:11)

### 4. INVEST \_\_\_\_\_

- Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ his life serving. (Mark 10:45, Matthew 6:19-20)
