The HOPE Offering is a call to sacrificial giving to fuel local and global outreach. It is based on 2 Corinthians 8-9 where we see modeled sacrificial giving, which is above and beyond regular giving, to help fulfill the Great Commandment and Great Commission of Jesus Christ!

One-hundred percent of the HOPE Offering will go towards local and global outreach, including these seven HOPE initiatives this year:

1. Mexico Missions – We will continue to support and participate in trips and projects with ióeight. After an amazing trips in the past, we are continuing to support theses mission efforts for our church to go on these trips. Watch a [Mexico Missions Highlight video from our 2019 trip here](#).
2. Community Service Projects – We will continue to support and encourage our CARES team to serve our community. This team focuses on helping those who need hope through mercy, financial aid, supporting foster and adoption families, and helping minister to families in times of need. We do this through meals, visitation, and handyman fixes. Specifically, we are planning to send a team into



the community based on referrals from people within our church. We want to completely meet the need if it's buying and replacing a washing machine for a single mom, or elderly person. If it's repairing a car, painting a house, or school we want to pay for the supplies and send the people to do the job!

3. Big Day Events– Our vision is to provide a fun and safe place that is welcoming for our local community. We want to help serve our community with these events that support them and introduce them to North Valley Community Church. This year we will be offering a number of special events, classes, workshops, programs and services to help better meet the needs of our community and reach the North Valley for Christ! Last year's events included but were not limited to; a date night for couples, summer outreaches, a fall festival, financial workshops, marriage seminars, foster support group, Bible studies and special services, events and resources for our fall kick off, Christmas, Easter and Mother's Day services.
4. Student Ministry Camps - For the past six years we have sent our students to Camp at [UCYC in Prescott](#), Arizona. To do so, North Valley must give deposits pledges and scholarships to help offset the cost so that we can send as many students to experience these life-changing events. Camp continues to be a great place for kids and students to be challenged to grow in their faith. Help us send even more kids and expand the age range so that we can make this available for more students this year! We want to send more students than ever!
5. Starting and Strengthening Churches - Every year we contribute financially to help start and strengthen churches, both locally and globally. We do this through [our local church planting network](#) as well as by supporting churches directly. In previous years, we have been able to support churches here in [Phoenix](#), in [Los Angeles](#), and start brand new churches in Nepal through global partnerships! Our most recent church, Mission Grove launched with more than 240 people in attendance. We give financially, from our both our general fund and Hope Offering, each year to fuel these mission efforts!



6. The Navajo Nation Relief Efforts. Through the global pandemic the Navajos were hit hard. Many have suffered and some died. We as a church provided relief efforts with food. This year we want to continue to be part of relief efforts there.
7. Our Local Police and Firefighters. We have formed a unique relationship with our local first responders and will continue to support the men and women in uniforms.

All monies given will help scholarships, offset, or cover the costs of the trips, events, programs, or special outreach services.
