



How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your Neighborhood Group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps.

Pastor Ryan's Main Idea

“Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life (John 11:25)”

Key Questions:

- What did you connect with in Otch's life story and why?
- Look at the observations of the 4 tombs taught on Sunday and share your thoughts on them.
- What were you most surprised with about the Lazarus story? (John 11)

Optional Questions: If needed, include one or more of these Scriptures and/or questions to extend your conversation.

- Read Isaiah 55:8-9 and discuss how God's plans are always higher. How has this been true in your life recently? Is there an area where you perhaps didn't believe this in your life this week?
- Discuss John 11:25-27. Do you believe this as good news?
- Discuss John 11:32. How have you pursued His presence this week?

Next Step:

- Take some time this week to get by yourself to think, pray and read God's word. Take a major decision or situation that you are facing in life right now and bring it to God. Pray and ask the Good Shepherd to guide you, then share with a friend or the group what you sense the Good Shepherd may be leading you to do. Once you confirm that it's the Lord leading, then go for it!
