The Example and Exhortations of Jesus The Night Before His Death

1. Jesus lays down his **life**.
John 15:12-13, John 10:11, Romans 5:7–8, 1 Peter 3:18, John 10:18, John 3:16
2. Jesus calls his disciples **friends**.
John 15:14-15, John 15:18-19, James 4:4, 1 John 3:16
3. Jesus chose and appointed his disciples to **go**.
John 15:16, Acts 1:8, Psalms 67, Genesis 12:1-3, Matthew 28:19-20
4. Jesus commands his disciples to **love one another**.
John 15:17, John 13:34-35, 1 John 3:16

Communion

If you've placed your faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, we invite you to partake in Communion wherever you happen to be worshipping. Here are some steps that we encourage you to follow:

1. Prepare a small piece of bread (cracker or similar) and a small cup of grape juice (or something similar) that can serve as the elements of Communion.
2. Take a few moments and read 1 Corinthians 11:23-25.
3. Spend a few moments in prayer (silently or aloud) confessing your sins to him and thanking Jesus for the forgiveness of sins and eternal life he offers you today.
4. Partake in the elements of Communion as you are ready.
