- #2 The return of Christ is not the rapture.

- #5 King Jesus will come on his warhorse.
- #6 King Jesus will come with the armies of heaven.
- #7 King Jesus will strike down the nations.

4. The second coming, (the rapture and the return of Christ) is one of the most dominant subjects in the Bible outside of salvation. Why do you think we as believers have tended to focus mostly on His first coming, (The incarnation, i.e. Christmas, the birth of Jesus) vs. His second coming?
5. Read Revelation 16:16. What do you recall about the Battle of Armageddon? What do you recall Pastor Ryan taught on about this subject?
6. Read Revelation 19:11 and Revelation 6:2. What's the difference? You might need to consider the context of the passage. Read before or after or both.
7. Read Revelation 19:14. What did we learn about the armies of Heaven?
8. In the end, we see that Jesus strikes down the nations and defeats the antichrist. (Rev. 19: 11-21) As believers how does this motivate you to live?
