Monday, July 12<sup>th</sup>

#### **READ**

1 Corinthians 15:35-44

#### **ASK**

- 1. What must that which is sown do first, before it comes to life?

- 3. What difference will it make to you this week that God promises to give you a spiritual body that is raised in glory, in power, and that is imperishable?
