

# The Anchor of our Mission

Acts 27–28:10



**Main Idea:** God's \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ give us the courage to continue to engage in His mission.

## SCENE 1: The Ship of Blessing – From Caesarea to Myra (27:1–5)

*Note God's gracious provision for Paul to complete His mission to preach the gospel in Rome.*

## SCENE 2: The Ship of Trial – From Myra to Malta (27:6–44)

*Note Paul's faith demonstrated in the face of life-threatening trials.*

- B. Servants of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ to share God's Word, vv. 21–24
- C. Servants of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ to trust in God's Word, v. 25.
- D. Servants of Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ for others, v. 24.
- E. God uses our faith during trials to give us \_\_\_\_\_ with unbelievers, vv. 27–44.

## SCENE 3: The Island of Opportunity – Malta (28:1–10)

*Note how God uses tragic circumstances to change people's perception of Paul and give him greater opportunities.*

- A. God will \_\_\_\_\_ his promises in us, vv.1–7.
