Growth Group Questions



1. On Sunday, we were sent out on a mission! We went out into our community in order to observe, listen and pray so that God could teach us to have His heart for spiritually lost people. Report briefly to your group about WHERE you went and WHY you chose that place. It's encouraging to think about the many, many places where God took Paseo del Reyans this past Sunday morning!
2. Keep your finger in the text! Find at least one Bible verse or passage that teaches us about God's heart for people or that describes the variety of people that Jesus cared for. Read it with your group and discuss as needed.
3. Read Luke chapter 15 and John 17:13-18 together. What do these passages teach us in regard to our role as hell raiders?
4. Share with your group how God worked in your life through Sunday morning's mission. How was that experience? What did God reveal to you? Did you sense the Holy Spirit speaking to you? Did anything interesting happen? What will you remember/take away from going on that mission?
5. As Easter season approaches, who will you be praying for? Who could you invite to the Egg Hunt, Journey to the Cross, or Easter worship gatherings? Do you know someone who might desire the training and encouragement of the 9-week Financial Peace University course?
6. Pray for one another. Ask God to give us His heart for people. Ask Him to work in and through us as hell raiders.
