1. Share something that many in your group do not know yet: What's one thing you can't live without?

2. It was mentioned last Sunday that apart from Christ, there can be no life. Do you agree with this? Why or why not?

3. Read our study passage in John 15.1-8. Take time to also study the following:

How do these verses substantiate the statement in #2? How should this truth change our perspective and the way we live?

4. Share if you (or your anonymous friend) have an experience in being "connected but disconnected". More importantly, what are some practical ways to disconnect so that we can be connected?

5. Since the fruit is simply the out-forming of what has passed through the branch from the vine, we should ask, "What is it that we receive from the vine"? Let's read ahead for next week's passage (read John 15.9-17). What kind of organic fruit are we then supposed to bear?
