2. Over the course of your Christian life, how have you stored up treasures in heaven (6:20)? What specific treasures have you sent ahead? How are you going to do this in the future?
3. Where have you invested in earthly treasures (6:21)? How can you become more content with what God has entrusted to you?
4. Would others describe you as a generous person (6:22–23)? Why or why not? How can you make additional sacrifices to bless others? How can you strive to increase your standard of giving instead of your standard of living?
5. Can I honestly say that God is my only master (6:24)? What competes for first-place in your life? How can I put the Lord back on His rightful throne? Who can hold you accountable in this commitment? Whom do you admire for the way he or she handles money? What does that person do that you would like to emulate or do better?
