1. Read John 3.1-18 together and share observations/highlights from the text. What is something that you remember from Sunday that has stood out to you?
2. In John 20.31, John shares that his hope for us as readers is that we may “believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God and by believing we may have life.” What does a life that has experienced a spiritual rebirth look like? In one of John’s later books, 1 John, he seeks to answer that very question (see 1 John 5.13). Read the following passages in 1 John and discuss some of the evidences of God’s work in a born-again heart:
 - 1 John 2.3-4
 - 1 John 2.5-6
 - 1 John 2.15-17
 - 1 John 2.29 (see Galatians 5.16-25)
 - 1 John 3.9-10
 - 1 John 4.7-8
 - 1 John 4.13-16
 - 1 John 4.20
 - 1 John 5:1-5
3. What is the ultimate “result” of being born again? How is that personally encouraging for you today, in your season of life?
4. Share with one another evidences of God’s work in your life, and celebrate God’s victories! How has God awakened us to Him, and transformed us to be more like Him?
