Growth Group Questions



1. Read Genesis 3 aloud together. Compare verses 7-13 with chapter 2. How has the relationship changed between the man and the woman? How has the relationship they had with God changed?
2. Why do you think God would allow Adam and Eve to fail when tempted? What does this say about God? What does this say about what He wants from us?
3. From this passage, how would you define sin and its consequences?
4. Where in this passage do you find the Good News?
5. Spend some time praying for one another, asking for our Heavenly Father's help as we learn to walk by the Holy Spirit and glorify Jesus in our lives.

For Personal Reflection:

Take some time to honestly consider any past or ongoing sexual sin in your life. Read 1 Corinthians 6:11, Psalm 51, and 1 John 1:9. Now, take some time to pray... confess your sin to God and receive His forgiveness. If your sexual immorality hurt someone else (read Matthew 5:23-24), seek forgiveness and reconciliation. If you have suffered as a result of sexual sin against you, go to Jesus for help and healing... and don't hesitate to seek the care of a pastor or professional therapist (ask a pastor if you need a recommendation).
