Growth Group Questions

1. How does your family/church family react when one of its members is in trouble? How does this affect you?

2. Read Genesis 13:12 and then 14:12. How might Lot have ended up there? Did Scriptures give any clues as to where Lot's life direction was headed? How might we avoid ending up in "Sodom?"

3. Do you think Lot deserved to be rescued? Perhaps he deserved his fate? Could Abram have avoided risks and elected to do nothing?

4. On Sunday, Abram's pursuit and rescue of Lot was compared to Christ's pursuit and rescue of Christians. Suggest, find and consider together what Scriptures teach about Christ's pursuit of us. Don't concern yourselves with finding one particular, "right" answer. Instead, encourage one another from God's Word about how Jesus pursues and rescues!

5. Read John 14:27 and 16:33 aloud together. Share one way that Jesus has been your peace in the midst of life's troubles.
