A. Two Truths to Anchor Your Life:

1. God is always Good, and always works Good.
2 Chronicles 7.3, Psalm 86.5, 135.3, 145.9, Jeremiah 33.11, Nahum 1.7;
Genesis 50.20, Romans 8.28, Acts 2.22-23, Colossians 1.15-17, etc.

2. God uses Suffering for Good and even greater Glory.
Romans 8.18, 2 Corinthians 4.16-18, Isaiah 43.7, 53.3, Luke 24.26,
Acts 9.16, Romans 5.3, 1 Peter 4.12-13, etc.

C. Keep Remembering the Two Truths:

1. God is always Good, and always works Good.
2. God uses Suffering for Good and even greater Glory.
