

## Growth Group Questions

**“What Pleases Jesus at His Supper?”**

**1 Corinthians 10:15-22 and 11:17-34**

**Messy Church 20**

**Week of June 13, 2010**



1. Typically, what is your experience during the Lord's Supper? What helps you connect with the Lord? What hinders you?

2. What very concrete steps, actions, changes could you make to better please Jesus at His Supper?

3. Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-20. It's unsettling that sometimes our doing Christian "stuff" can defeat its own purpose. What attitudes in us might do more harm than good in Bible Study, serving, worship, giving, the Lord's Supper, etc? Read Isaiah 1:11-17 and see how it helps your thinking and processing.

4. What might the snubbed, so called "second class" Christians have felt at the Lord's Supper in Corinth, 1 Corinthians 11:21-22, 33-34? How might this lead a brother or sister to feel like they "don't belong" here or are not needed, see 1 Corinthians 12:15.

5. Consider James 2:1-4. What effect might such behavior have on watching nonbelievers? What can you do this Sunday (and the Sundays following) to help make Paseo del Rey Church a more welcoming and inclusive place, for Jesus' sake?
