SERMON NOTES

AT THE CROSS SERMON SERIES We See The Great Exchange Deuteronomy 21:22-23; Galatians 3:13; 2 Corinthians 5:21

"The cross shows us the seriousness of our sin-but also shows us the immeasurable love of God." Billy Graham

THE CURSE (Deuteronomy 21:22-23)

- The hanging was the outward sign of the curse on the individual.
- The burial of the individual was the sign that the curse was sufficient.

THE CURE (Galatians 3:13)

- Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law.
- In Jesus, the law was fulfilled. He did not remain on the "tree" through the night.
- His burial was the sign that sin was put away.
- His resurrection was the beginning of a new life for Himself as Redeemer; and for us as redeemed.

THE EXCHANGE (2 Corinthians 5:21)

- Because of Adam's sin, death and sin are imputed to all. (Romans 5:12-14)
- At the cross, God imputed our sin to Christ.
- At the cross, God imputed Christ's perfect righteousness to us.
