AT THE CROSS: We See God's Love Romans 5:6-11

"The cross of Jesus is the supreme evidence of the love of God." Oswald Chambers

The Great Contrast (v8a)

- But God......
- Paul is contrasting the love of man and the love of God.
- God demonstrates (openly shows) His love for us.
- God's love is unconditional and sacrificial.

Jesus Died For Sinners (v8b)

- Every person without Christ is a sinner.
- He did the utmost for us when we were the least deserving of it.

There Is "Much More" (v9)

- We now stand justified before God.
- Our justification is only through the blood of Jesus.
- We are saved from God's eternal wrath.
