# SALT AND LIGHT WEEK ONE MATTHEW 5:13

# Four Characteristics of Salt:

# Salt is distinctive.

Christians have distinctive calls. (James 1:27) Christians are to think in a distinctive way. (Romans 12:2)

## Salt flavors.

Christian lives have been "flavored" in a new way. (2 Corinthians 5:17) Christians should add God's "flavoring" daily. (Ephesians 4:24)

### Salt penetrates. Christians have fruits planted in their hearts. (Galatians 5:22-23) Christian fruits should be identifiable by others. (1 Peter 3:4)

Salt preserves. Christians rely on God's strength each day. (Galatians 6:9) Christians can look forward to God completing the work He has begun in us. (Phil 1:6)
