Graduation Sermon Milestones, Landmines, and Safe Harbors Philippians 2:12-18

Milestones- Celebrating Accomplishments (Phil. 2:13)

There are many Biblical accounts of great accomplishments:

- In Genesis 12 Abraham leaves his homeland and takes a journey to become the father of many nations.
- In Exodus 14 Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt and through the Red Sea.
- In 1 Samuel 17, David trusts God and defeats a giant.

Land Mines- Overcoming Challenges (Phil. 2:14-15)

1 Peter 5:8

- Joseph experiences temptation and betrayal but will later rise to prominence.
- Daniel remains faithful in the face of adversity and is delivered in the lion's den.
- Paul perseveres through trials and persecution for the sake of the gospel.
