SERMON NOTES

Preoccupied With Prayer. Mighty in Ministry. Mark 1:29-39

"Jesus was both intentional in ministry and isolated in prayer." Alan Taylor

Can an isolated person be an intentional person?

Jesus was Intentional in Ministry. (vv. 29-34)

Jesus sets the example in ministering to individuals.

Amid many people in Jericho, he seeks out Zacchaeus and transforms his life. (Luke 19:1-10)

He goes out of his way to find the Samaritan woman at Jacob's Well. (John 4:1-42)

In a crushing press of people, he feels the touch on the hem of his garment and heals the woman of her disease. (Mark 5:24-34)

Jesus was Isolated in Prayer (vv. 35-37)

In verse 35, Mark uses four verbs to describe the prayer life of Jesus (rising/departed/went/prayed).

There are Scriptural references to Jesus in solitary prayer.

Before his temptation. (Mark 1:12-13)

At the beginning of his ministry. (Mark 1:14)

Before teaching. (Luke 6:12-13)

When grieving. (Matthew 14:13)

In times of rest. (Matthew 14:23)

At death. (Mark 15:25)

Jesus Drew Strength and Guidance From His Prayer Life to Fuel His Intentional Ministry (vv. 38-39)

Alone with God. No interferences. No other voices. No excuses.
