



SERMON NOTE March 31, 2024

A Borrowed Tomb

Isaiah 53:9

I. Introduction

- A. Christ has died by crucifixion.
 - 1. The need to bury him before the Sabbath
 - 2. A secret disciple asks for the body of Christ
 - 3. The prophecy fulfilled by Joseph of Arimathea.

II. Body

- A. The Solemn Burial (Matthew 27: 57-60)
 - 1. The family tomb of Joseph.
 - 2. The burial process.
- B. The Sealing of the Tomb (Matthew 27:62-66)
 - 1. The stone represents the despair of death.
 - 2. The stone is sealed by the enemies of Jesus.
 - 3. The stone is meant to separate Jesus from his disciples.
- C. The Tomb Could Not Hold Jesus. (Matthew 28:1-10)
 - 1. The resurrection declares Christ is the Son of God. (Romans 1:4)
 - 2. His resurrection was not hidden. (1 Cor. 15:3-8)
 - 3. Salvation is found only in Jesus (Acts 4:12)
