Text: Luke 24:13-35

INTRODUCTION: We can really pour our time and focus into Easter. And yet we show our true Love and THANKFULNESS to God by how we WALK each day of our life. *(Ephesians 4:1) (Ephesians 5:2) (Ephesians 5:8) (Ephesians 5:15)*

I. THEIR STATE OF CONFUSION *(Luke 24:13-18) (Psalm 139:2-3)*

- **“What are you discussing together as you walk along?”** *(Luke 24:17)*
- **“What things?”** *(Luke 24:19)*

II. The Lights Go On *(Luke 24:25-27)*

- **REBUKE** -- Jesus gently rebukes - *“How foolish you are”*
- **EXPLANATION** -- Jesus gently Explains *(Luke 24:44-46)*
- **THE REVELATION** -- Jesus gently reveals Himself
- **ARRIVAL IN EMMAUS** *(Luke 24:30-32)*

III. THE WALK BECOMES A RUN *(Luke 24:33-35) (Matthew 5:16)*

APPLICATION: *(1 Corinthians 15:3-4)*

ASK THESE QUESTIONS:

- Can someone you are with today, remember a time when their heart burned because they encountered Christ?
- Ask the people around you where they have seen Jesus working.
- Who have you seen Jesus working in, and personally how has Jesus worked through you today? *(1 John 1:7)*
