1. The Bible

1.1 The Bible contains 66 books -- 39 books in the Old Testament and 27 books in the New Testament -- inspired and directed by the Holy Spirit and communicated through human authors. The Bible is God's word in written form true and without error in the original writings.

1.2 The Bible is the complete revelation of God's will for saving mankind and is the final authority on all matters pertaining to life and death. The authority of the Bible depends on God alone and not on the testimony of any person or church.

1.3 While our human limitations and sinfulness may keep us from knowing God's truth completely, through the work of the Holy Spirit, we can know God's word rightly, in order that we might believe, trust and obey. Wherever the Bible is less clear it must be understood in light of passages which are more clear. The Bible will stand till the end of time and lacks nothing.

(14) He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

⁸ 2 Peter 1:20-21 - knowing this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture comes from someone's own interpretation. (21) For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

2. The Trinity

2.1 There is one living and true God.¹⁰ He eternally exists as the all-knowing, all-powerful, invisible, immortal¹¹, and infinitely perfect God. God, one in essence, exists in three persons¹² - Father,¹³ Son¹⁴ and Holy Spirit¹⁵ - each person being fully God, co-eternal, co-equal, sharing this essence in its entirety.

2.2 God is self-existent and self-sufficient, having perfect love, joy, and fellowship within the Trinity¹⁶. He is the creator of all things,¹⁷ yet having all life in and of Himself, ¹⁸ he has no need of

His creation.¹⁹ He upholds and sustains all things by His perfect will and rule.²⁰ God deserves all worship and obedience.²¹

God The Father

- 2.3 God the Father is all loving and all wise.²² He is the first person of the Trinity and all things were created from Him and exist for Him.²³ He wills both creation and redemption.²⁴ He is the ruler of heaven and earth with Jesus Christ seated with him on his royal throne.²⁵
- 2.4 Though he is Father to all creation,²⁶ he is revealed as father uniquely to his people. First, to the people of Israel,²⁷ and now, to all his children who are adopted through belief in the gospel.²⁸

God the Son (Jesus)

2.5 Jesus, God the Son,²⁹ was the word at the beginning.³⁰ He is the second person of the Trinity and all things were created and exist through Him.³¹ He is eternal and coequal with the Father and the Holy Spirit.³² He was born of a virgin and came to earth as a man.³³ Being both fully God³⁴ and fully man,³⁵ he was tempted in every way that we are tempted,

(18) No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.

(38) And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.; **Philippians 2:6-7** - who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, (7) but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

³⁴ John 10:30-33 - I and the Father are one." (31) The Jews picked up stones again to stone him. (32) Jesus answered them, "I have shown you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you going to stone me?" (33) The Jews answered him, "It is not for a good work that we are going to stone you but for blasphemy, because you, being a man, make yourself God."; 14:9 - Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and you still do not know me, Philip? Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?; Romans 1:2-4 - which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures, (3) concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh (4) and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord.

³⁵ **John 4:6** - Jacob's well was there; so Jesus, wearied as he was from his journey, was sitting beside the well. It was about the sixth hour.; **19:28** - After this, Jesus, knowing that all was now finished, said (to fulfill the Scripture), "I thirst."; **Colossians 2:9** - For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily

but prevailed against the temptation and lived the only perfect and sinless life in all history.³⁶

2.6 He willingly laid down his life,³⁷ being put to death by Roman crucifixion at the will of his own people.³⁸ On the cross the wrath of God was poured out on him for sin.³⁹ After three days in the grave, Jesus was raised from the dead⁴⁰ after which He walked among his friends and enemies for forty days⁴¹ until he ascended into heaven⁴² where he sits at the right hand of the Father⁴³ as our great high priest and advocate.⁴⁴

³⁶ 2 Corinthians 5:21 - For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.; 1 Peter 2:22-23 - He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in his mouth. (23) When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten, but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly; Isaiah 53:9 - And they made his grave with the wicked and with a rich man in his death, although he had done no violence, and there was no deceit in his mouth.; Hebrews 4:15 - For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

³⁸ **Philippians 2:8** - And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.; **Isaiah 53:3** - He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not.

³⁹ **1 Corinthians 15:3** - For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures; **1 Peter 2:24** - He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.; **1 John 2:1-2** - My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. (2) He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.; **Ephesians 1:7** - In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace; **Isaiah 53:4-6** - Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. (5) But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed. (6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all., **11-12** - Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities. (12) Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many,and makes intercession for the transgressors.; **Romans 3:23-25** - for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, (24) and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, (25) whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins.

⁴⁰ 1 Corinthians 15:4 - that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures

⁴¹ **1 Corinthians 15:5-7** - and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. (6) Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. (7) Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles.

⁴² **Acts 1:9-11** - And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. (10) And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, (11) and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.: **Philippians 2:9-11** - Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, (10) so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, (11) and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

⁴⁴ **Hebrews 4:14** - Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.; **7:23-25** - The former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office, (24) but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever. (25) Consequently, he is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through him, since he always lives to make intercession for them.; **9:13-15** - For if the blood of goats and bulls, and the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh, (14) how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God. (15) Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant.; **10:19** - Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus

God the Spirit

- 2.8 The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, being eternal and equally God, present with the Father and Son at creation. ⁴⁶ The Holy Spirit was promised by Jesus to indwell and empower each believer for the sake of the kingdom of God on earth. ⁴⁷
- 2.9 The Spirit convicts the world, ⁴⁸ guides the believer into truth, ⁴⁹ gives gifts to aid in the work of the gospel, ⁵⁰ gives supernatural power to the believer, ⁵¹ reveals the truth of the

According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, (4) to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, (5) who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.; **1 John 3:8** - Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil.; **John 14:6** - Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me

⁴⁶ **Genesis 1:2** - The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

(19) And I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and vapor of smoke; (20) the sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the day of the Lord comes, the great and magnificent day. (21) And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.', 4:29-30 - And now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness, (30) while you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus."

gospel and the Bible to the church,⁵² and seals the salvation of each believer.⁵³ To those the Spirit chooses, he regenerates, calls, enlightens, convicts, and hardens.⁵⁴

3. God's Eternal Purposes

3.1 God, according to his will,⁵⁵ unchangeably⁵⁶ foreknew and declared everything that occurs.⁵⁷ God upholds and governs all things⁵⁸ according to his purposes in such a way that He never sins⁵⁹ or is unjust.⁶⁰

3.2 God predestined those who would be saved through Jesus Christ,⁶¹ before the foundation of the world,⁶² according to his purpose and grace⁶³ and without regard for any condition or work of the elect.⁶⁴ By this, those who God chose, are delivered from bondage to sin,⁶⁵ brought to repentance,⁶⁶ saved through faith in Jesus Christ,⁶⁷ and enter into His eternal kingdom.⁶⁸

4. God's Creation

- 4.1 God created the universe and everything in it, both visible and invisible, out of nothing.⁶⁹ All His creation was very good.⁷⁰ God requires nothing,⁷¹ but created everything for His glory.⁷²
- 4.2 God created mankind⁷³, both male and female, equally in His image⁷⁴ and without sin.⁷⁵
- 4.3 Adam and Eve were created for God's glory and to live in relationship with one another,⁷⁶ establishing marriage as a one-flesh union between one man and one woman, each with differing and complementary roles which is a reflection of the loving relationship between Christ and the church.⁷⁷

(29) For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, (30) because we are members of his body. (31) "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." (32) This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. (33) However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

5. Man's Fall

5.1 Although God created Adam and Eve without sin, they were led astray by Satan⁷⁸ and sinned.⁷⁹ As a result of Adam's direct disobedience of God's command, each person is a sinner by nature and choice⁸⁰ corrupting the fellowship between God, mankind and all creation.⁸¹

5.2 Each person is corrupted in every aspect,⁸² enslaved to sin,⁸³ and are morally unable to delight in God.⁸⁴ Therefore, as children of wrath⁸⁵ mankind is condemned to death and eternal

(22) For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. (23) And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

Titus 1:15 - To the pure, all things are pure, but to the defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure; but both their minds and their consciences are defiled.; Genesis 6:5 - The LORD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.; Jeremiah 17:9 - The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it?; Romans 3:10-19 - as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; (11) no one understands; no one seeks for God. (12) All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one." (13) "Their throat is an open grave; they use their tongues to deceive." "The venom of asps is under their lips." (14) "Their mouth is full of curses and bitterness." (15) "Their feet are swift to shed blood; (16) in their paths are ruin and misery, (17) and the way of peace they have not known." (18) "There is no fear of God before their eyes." (19) Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, wso that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.; Ephesians 2:2-3 - in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—(3) among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

⁸³ James 1:14-15 - But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. (15) Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.; Romans 6:16 - Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?, 20 - For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness.

punishment. 86 Mankind is unable to save themselves or contribute in any way to their acceptance before God . 87

6. Gospel

6.1 Though everything God created was good, ⁸⁸ man destroyed that goodness with sin⁸⁹ and brought himself under the curse of the law. ⁹⁰ Even so, God made a way for the restoration of relationships between man, the world and God. ⁹¹ This work is revealed in the gospel, the true story of all of creation, with Jesus Christ as the center and it's full revelation. ⁹²

6.2 Jesus Christ lived the perfect life we should have lived, 93 died the death we should have died, 94 and rose again, proving his power over sin and death 95 in order to reconcile sinful man with a

⁹⁴ 1 Peter 3:18 - For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit

loving God who sacrificed himself to be with us. ⁹⁶ Through this good news, Jesus Christ is renewing and redeeming all creation to himself. ⁹⁷ All of God's work in Christ will come to completion in eternity and will last for eternity. ⁹⁸

7. Salvation

7.1 Mankind cannot save themselves. Salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. 99

7.2 Mankind, because they are spiritually dead in sin, ¹⁰⁰ cannot obey or please God. ¹⁰¹ God calls those He predestined ¹⁰² spiritually opening our eyes, ¹⁰³ enlightening our minds, ¹⁰⁴ and renewing our hearts. ¹⁰⁵ This regeneration frees us from slavery to sin ¹⁰⁶ into life ¹⁰⁷ in Jesus Christ. ¹⁰⁸

⁹⁶ 2 Corinthians 5:21 - For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

⁹⁷ Colossians 1:20 - and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross.

⁹⁸ **Revelation 21:1-7** - Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. (2) And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (3) And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (4) He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away." (5) And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true." (6) And he said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. To the thirsty I will give from the spring of the water of life without payment. (7) The one who conquers will have this heritage, and I will be his God and she will be my son.

⁹⁹ **Titus 3:5** - he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit

¹⁰⁰ **Ephesians 2:1** - And you were dead in the trespasses and sins, **5** - even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved

Romans 8:7-8 - For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. (8) Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.; Titus 3:3 - For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating one another.; John 6:44 - No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day; Romans 3:10-12 - as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; (11) no one understands; no one seeks for God. (12) All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one."

¹⁰² **Romans 8:30** - And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified., **11:7** - What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened; **Ephesians 1:4-5** - even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love (5) he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, **11** - In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will

¹⁰³ **2 Corinthians 4:4-6** - In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. 7.3 God justifies the elect,¹⁰⁹ declaring righteous those who, through faith in Christ, repent of their sins¹¹⁰ and submit to Jesus as Lord¹¹¹. Christ takes the punishment for our sin and gives us His righteousness¹¹² by His perfect life and death.¹¹³ Therefore, God's justice and wrath is fully and permanently satisfied on our behalf.¹¹⁴

(4) But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, (5) even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved— (6) and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus

Romans 10:9-10 - because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. (10) For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.; 1 Corinthians 12:3 - Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the Spirit of God ever says "Jesus is raccursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the Holy Spirit.; 2 Corinthians 4:5 - For what we proclaim is not ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord, with ourselves as your servants for Jesus' sake.; Philippians 2:11 - and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father

¹¹² **2 Corinthians 5:21** - For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness; **Romans 4:5-8** - And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness, (6) just as David also speaks of the blessing of the one to whom God counts righteousness apart from works: (7) "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, and whose sins are covered; (8) blessed is the man against whom the Lord will not zeount his sin."; **Ephesians 1:7** - In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace

Romans 8:1 - There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus., 3 - For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh; Galatians 3:13 - Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"; 1 Peter 1:18-19 - knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, (19) but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot; Isaiah 53:5 - But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

¹¹⁴ **1 Thessalonians 1:10** - and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.; **5:9** - For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ; **Romans 5:9-10** - Since, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God. (10) For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life., **8:1** - There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus., **38-39** - For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, (39) nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.; **1 Corinthians 1:4-8** - I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ Jesus, (5) that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge— (6) even as the testimony about Christ was confirmed among you— (7) so that you are not lacking in any gift, as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ, (8) who will sustain you to the end, guiltless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. (9) God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.; **John 5:24** - Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

7.4 All who are justified are adopted by God^{115} made heirs of God^{116} and given the Holy Spirit¹¹⁷ who guarantees our inheritance. ¹¹⁸

8. Church

8.1 There is one universal church of all true believers from all time. It consists of those who are chosen in Christ, ¹¹⁹ united with Christ through faith by the Spirit, ¹²⁰ submitted to Christ, ¹²¹ and prepared by Christ for eternity. ¹²² The visible or local church is a covenant community of baptized believers who carry out the work designed for the church by God¹²³.

¹¹⁷ **Romans 8:15** - For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!"

¹¹⁸ **Ephesians 1:5** - he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, **11** - In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, **13-14** - In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, (14) who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.; **4:30** - And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.; **1 Peter 1:5** - who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time; **Jude 24** - Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy

¹¹⁹ **John 10:16** - And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd., **15:16** - You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.

^{120 1} John 1:3 - that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.; **Ephesians 4:3-6** - eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (4) There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— (5) one Lord, one faith, one baptism, (6) aone God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

¹²¹ **Ephesians 1:22-23** - And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, (23) which is his body, the fullness of him who fills all in all., **4:15-16** - Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, (16) from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love., **5:23** - For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.; **Colossians 1:18** - And he is the head of the body, the church. ¹²³ **Acts 8:1** - And Saul approved of his execution. And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.; **1 Corinthians 16:19** - The churches of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Prisca, together with the church in their house, send you hearty greetings in the Lord.

8.2 The purpose of the church is glorify God¹²⁴ and make disciples.¹²⁵ For this reason, the local church is the primary method for offering the gospel to every tribe and tongue and people and nation.¹²⁶

8.3 The Holy Spirit continues to work in and through the church giving spiritual gifts as in the New Testament.¹²⁷ These gifts are neither essential for salvation nor an indication of spiritual maturity, but are designed to empower the church to fulfill its purpose by testifying to the gospel¹²⁸ and building up the church.¹²⁹ They are to be eagerly desired and lovingly practiced.¹³⁰

¹²⁴ **Ephesians 3:10** - so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.; **Matthew 5:14-16** - "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. (15) Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. (16) In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

¹²⁵ Matthew 28:18-20 - And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. (19) Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (20) teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And I will show you a still more excellent way.; 14:1 - Pursue love, and earnestly desire the spiritual gifts, especially that you may prophesy.

8.4 Each local church should recognize and affirm¹³¹ the calling of spiritually qualified men¹³² to give leadership to the church and oversight to its teaching through the role of pastor-elder.¹³³

9. Ordinances

9.1 There are two Scriptural ordinances which are to be continued until Christ's second coming: Baptism¹³⁴ and the Lord's Supper¹³⁵ (Eucharist).

Baptism

9.2 Baptism is only for those who have repented and come to faith through the gospel. Baptism is not necessary for salvation, but is the first step of obedience for believers. Baptism is a public proclamation where we identify ourselves with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection. It represents death to our old life of sin and resurrection to new life in Christ.

¹³¹ **Acts 14:23** - And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, with prayer and fasting they committed them to the Lord in whom they had believed.; **Titus 1:5** - This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you

¹³² **1 Timothy 3:1-7** - The saying is trustworthy: If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task. (2) Therefore an overseer must be above reproach, the husband of one wife,(2) sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, (3) not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. (4) He must manage his own household well, with all dignity keeping his children submissive, (5) for if someone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God's church? (6) He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil. (7) Moreover, he must be well thought of by outsiders, so that he may not fall into disgrace, into a snare of the devil.; **Titus 1:5-9** - This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you— (6) if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. (7) For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, (8) but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. (9) He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.

¹³³ 1 Timothy 2:12-13 - I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. (13) For Adam was formed first, then Eve

(6) We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin. (7) For zone who has died has been set free from sin. (8) Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

9.3 Proclaim does not baptize infants of believing families. Though we welcome children into our visible covenant community, true membership is for believers who have made a public confession of faith by water baptism. The mode of baptism follows what is found in the Scripture, full immersion in water, 140 whenever possible.

The Lord's Supper

9.4 The Lord's Supper, also known as communion or the Eucharist, is for gathered believers¹⁴¹. Prior to his crucifixion, Christ ate his last meal with his disciples and commanded them to remember his body given and blood shed for his people. Therefore, the Lord's Supper is a time of remembrance for the believer.¹⁴²

9.5 When believers participate in communion they share, not physically, but spiritually, in the body and blood of Christ to their spiritual benefit.¹⁴³ There is no sacrifice of Christ in the observance of communion. Rather, it is a remembrance of the sacrifice of Christ once for all¹⁴⁴ and a proclamation of Christ's death until He comes.¹⁴⁵ Therefore, each believer should prepare their heart before partaking in communion, confessing and repenting of any sin in their life.¹⁴⁶

¹⁴⁰ **Matthew 3:16** - And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him; **John 3:23** - John also was baptizing at Aenon near Salim, because water was plentiful there, and people were coming and being baptized; **Acts 8:36-39** - And as they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?" (38) And he commanded the chariot to stop, and they both went down into the water, Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him. (39) And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.

¹⁴¹ **1 Corinthians 11:17-20** - But in the following instructions I do not commend you, because when you come together it is not for the better but for the worse. (18) For, in the first place, when you come together as a church, I hear that there are divisions among you. And I believe it in part, (19) for there must be factions among you in order that those who are genuine among you may be recognized. (20) When you come together, it is not the Lord's supper that you eat., **22** - What! Do you not have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God and humiliate those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I commend you in this? No, I will not.

(17) Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.; **John 6:53-57** - So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. (54) Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. (55) For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. (56) Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him. (57) As the Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so whoever feeds on me, he also will live because of me., **63** - It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.

¹⁴⁴ **Hebrews 9:25-28** - Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own, (26) for then he would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. (27) And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment, (28) so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him.

10. Christian Living

10.1 Redeemed people are to live in a redeeming way in all areas of life.¹⁴⁷ Indeed, the faith by which the elect receive redemption necessarily produces, by the Holy Spirit and the Word,¹⁴⁸ transformed lives¹⁴⁹ as their minds are renewed by faith in Christ.¹⁵⁰

10.2 Christians are marked by the pursuit of reconciliation and the Fruit of the Spirit.¹⁵¹ We are to live in love¹⁵² and unity, generosity and hospitality,¹⁵³ forgiving one another,¹⁵⁴ and meeting regularly.¹⁵⁵ We care for the poor and marginalized and are marked as distinctly different than the rest of fallen mankind.¹⁵⁶

¹⁴⁷ Matthew 5:23-26 - So if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, (24) leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. (25) Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are going with him to court, lest your accuser hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you be put in prison. ¹⁵¹ **Galatians 5:22-23** - But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, (23) gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

¹⁵² 1 Peter 4:8 - Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

¹⁵⁴ **Ephesians 4:32** - But recall the former days when, after you were enlightened, you endured a hard struggle with sufferings,; **Colossians 3:13** - bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

¹⁵⁵ **Hebrews 10:25** - not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

¹⁵⁶ James 1:27 - Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: sto visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.; 1 Peter 2:12 - Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8 - For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; (4) that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, (5) not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God; (6) that no one transgress and wrong his brother in this matter, because the Lord is

11. Eternal State

11.1 At an appointed time that no man will know, ¹⁶⁰ Jesus Christ will visibly return to the earth, ¹⁶¹ in the flesh ¹⁶² and in power, ¹⁶³ to renew all things. ¹⁶⁴

11.2 Jesus will raise the dead¹⁶⁵ and judge everyone who has ever lived¹⁶⁶: God's people to eternal joy with their Creator¹⁶⁷ and God's enemies (those who did not believe the gospel) to eternal punishment in hell.¹⁶⁸ Heaven and hell are literal places that last for eternity.¹⁶⁹

11.3 After the final judgement, Christ will usher in His final and earthly kingdom, bringing heaven on earth.¹⁷⁰ For all eternity we will worship Him for His mercy toward us and His justice against sin.¹⁷¹

(13) I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end."; 2 Corinthians 5:10 - For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.; Ecclesiastes 12:14 - For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.; Matthew 12:36 - I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak; Romans 14:10 - Why do you pass judgment on your brother? Or you, why do you despise your brother? For we will all stand before the judgment seat of God, 12 - So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.
